Rules & Regulations

• Age Limit: Players should be born on or after 01.01.2018

The participant must produce a valid birth certificate to prove his /her age. Certificates from School will not be accepted. Certificates should preferably be from the Panchayat, Municipality or Corporation obtained soon after birth. The date of birth certificates registered within one year of the birth of the player alone will be recognized and allowed to participate. No District association shall recommend any player who doesn't come under the above criteria.

• Eligibility:

- Any player residing in West Bengal, born on or after 01.01.2018 can participate subject to approval of the concerned District Chess Association.
- 4 representatives (2 from Open and 2 from Girls) from each affiliated Dist.
 Association will get 50% refund of entry fees.

Selection:

Top 2 players (both Open & Girls) will be selected for participating in the respective National Chess Championship.

• Entry Details:

Entry Fee: Rs 1,000/-; **Last Date Of Entry**: 29-04-2025 (upto 02:00 pm) SBDS reserves the right to accept or reject any entry without assigning any reason. Birth certificate should be uploaded(Mandatory) for those who do not have any FIDE id.

System Of Play:

The Championship will be played under FIDE's Laws of Chess and the Swiss system. Maximum 8 Rounds of games will be played. Standard Rating will be considered in the tournament.

Time Control: The rate of play shall be 30 minutes with an increment of 30 seconds per move from move number one.

Pairing: Separate pairing will be done for Open and Girls groups.

Default Time: Default time for arriving to the chessboard is 30 minutes

Tie Break: Latest tie-break rules will be followed

• Prizes:

Trophies will be awarded to the top 15 in each of Open and Girls group.

Protests:

Protest, if any, against the decision of the Chief Arbiter shall be made in writing with a protest fee of Rs.1000/- by Cash within 10 minutes of the occurrence of the incident. The protest fee will be refunded if the appeal is upheld.

• Appeals Committee:

Before the commencement of the tournament, a three members appeals committee shall be formed by the SBDS/organizers.

• Interpretation:

For interpretation of the rule(s) and deciding any point not covered by the above rules of the tournament, the decision of the Tournament Committee shall be final and binding on all. The Tournament Committee has every right to make any addition or amendment to these rules, subject to SBDS clearance. However, such changes will be displayed in the tournament hall.

• Withdrawal:

If any player absents himself in any round without written intimation to Chief Arbiter, he will be treated as withdrawn himself.

Disqualification:

No participant will leave the venue before the Prize Distribution function without the permission of the Chief Arbiter.

• Registration with SBDS:

• Electronic Devices:

All Electronic devices including Electronic wrist watches are not allowed in the tournament hall.

Accommodation:

Outstation Players will have to arrange their own accommodation.
